## Coaching, Grading and Appointments Chairman's Report

---

Another big picture win for ACTRRA with two finals series being successfully completed with focus on the games themselves and no complaints about the refereeing.

A harder year on both the appointments and coaching sides this year with the drop in active referees making it necessary for two active Referee Coaches to move back into Refereeing Premier grade Rugby. Coaching numbers with further thinned by the unfortunate illness of Wilf Hedley a prolific Referee Coach. I have listed number of reports using RRIMS/Sideline as a marker (there are many reports done on paper or thumbnails not included in here that I believe show a much clearer picture across the juniors in particular):

- 2017 – 147 reports/GPRs by 19 coaches on 64 different referees; and
- 2018 – 103 reports/GPRs by 15 coaches on 57 different referees

Chad Burnell made his First Grade debut this year, extremely well deserved as no referee works harder on self-improvement. Mitch Beissner and Reuben Keane continued on their upward trajectory both refereeing Premier 2<sup>nd</sup> grade this year. I would like to further congratulate Brodie Ingram, Reuben Keane, Sarah Corrigan, James Hagan & James Morris for being recognised with higher honours this year at the National Schoolboy's Championships (Brodie & Rueben), Super W (Brodie, Reuben & Sarah), World Series 7s Sydney (James M & Reuben), Australian Barbarians v New Zealand Schools (Brodie), AON7s (Reuben), U19 NRC (Reuben, Sarah & James H) and the Men's Oceania 7s (Reuben). As a small Association we are punching above our weight.

Although numbers we down we still saw our members enjoying team training through the Brett Bowden in the pre-season and Form Fitness during the season.

I have decided that I will not be standing for the role of Chair of Coaching and Grading next year, this is not a reflection on the committee itself they have again been outstanding. As my refereeing became more active this year with our drop in numbers I found it harder to commit to the time required to coach and develop members, this coupled with allegations of self-aggrandisement and self-promotion have left me feeling that I am no longer the right person for this role.

In keeping with tradition, I would like to finish on a positive. Without the tireless efforts of Geoff Palmer and Rob Boyes shuffling bodies around the appointments, neither ACTRU nor ACTJRU would have had a competition this year. ## U19 Coaching and Grading Coordinators Report

### Summary

2018 was the year where hopefully we hit the bottom for Referee numbers and next year we will start to lift again.

An analysis of Junior Referee numbers showed a drop of 40% in registered junior referees from 2017 to 2018. This was made up primarily of a massive drop of 70% of referees not returning and we gained about 30% in new referee numbers.

Early on in the season we knew numbers would be tight so we put in a strategy to advise clubs as soon as practical if they would have a referee or not for the weekend. This along with a number of referees doing multiple games led to only about 10% of games going unappointed. To all those who did multiple games each week, the clubs and the association owes you a big thanks. The main contributors were David Murphy, Nathan Mass, Hamish Innes, Hayden Pepper, Adam Onus, Irene Jones and Marc Hastie. All who did over 20 games in a 12 round competition.

Hopefully the re-introduction of the RDO will assist us recruit and retain members.

### Development

This year saw a number of junior referees identified in a Junior Development squad. These young referees were given additional Referee coaching and they all benefited from this and have set a great platform for 2019 and beyond. It is good to note that the majority of the squad did Grand Final appointments as the Referee. Congratulations to them all.

We need to ensure that Referee numbers start to increase. This can only be done by all parties supporting and developing our junior referee. The Executive need to put plans in place to ensure that the Brumbies and ACTJRU continue to support our junior referees, be that increased match payments, travel allowances to ensure Referees outside Canberra are looked after and referee abuse is continually monitored and reported. Senior Referees need to find time to mentor the younger refs and as an association we ensure everyone is dressed properly and supported.

## Brumbies Rugby - Referee Department Report

---

### Introduction

Season 2018 saw some constructive steps being made for the future of referees in Canberra and surrounding regions. Although we still faced some issues in regards to referee numbers, there are many positives to take out of the year. Over the off-season, there was a major focus on the recruitment and development of junior referees and we saw a significant increase in this area. In 2019, we will continue to drive the development of these young referees and shift our focus to the recruitment of referees in our senior ranks after seeing a decline in this area over the last few years.

There is also some positive news in the referee development space, where a new role has been created to assist with the development, recruitment and retention of Match Officials across the Unions of ACT / Southern NSW, Victoria, South Australia and Tasmania. The new role, Match Official Manager – Southern States, will be employed by Rugby Australia and will be based in Melbourne. This role will be visible on a regular basis in our region. This is a great step forward to a dedicated resource for referee development.

Brodie Ingram continued his part time role within the Brumbies, running the Junior Education courses over the year, which gained a lot of positive feedback from clubs and participants.

2017 provided a number of opportunities for ACTRRA members to get out and referee outside of the normal senior and junior competition matches each weekend. These events were a great reward for those referees to get a chance to referee in front of some big crowds and exciting atmospheres.

ACTRRA members were provided the chance to be involved in Brumbies home games, Uni North juniors & Queanbeyan seniors 7's tournaments and multiple representative programs and friendly matches throughout the year.

### Recruitment and Retention

In 2018, ACTRRA had a total of 123 active registered referee members, this is an increase on the 114 registered members in 2017. To see growth this year in referee numbers is a great turnaround after we saw a decline of more than 30 referees over the previous year.

There were 68 (82 last season) referees retained from 2017 but a total of 55 (32 last season) new referees for the 2018 season, 33 (20 last season) of these members were under the age of 18. This shows that the great work with recruitment of referees, particularly juniors is starting to show positive results however there are still areas of improvement in the recruitment of senior referees and retaining as many referees from this season as possible.

Brodie Ingram continued his work with Brumbies Rugby in recruitment this year and ran a total of 8 (6 last season) Refereeing Kids Rugby courses this year which proved a reasonably successful recruitment drive, especially in the junior referee ranks.

### Appointments

The referee appointments for the 2018 season were coordinated by Geoff Palmer & Steve Peak for Seniors, with Rob Boyes running the Juniors.

This year we faced some challenges with the week to week appointments for both the Senior & Junior ranks. With the shortage of referees compared to the number of games each week, the appointment process was quite a difficult one with a number of senior matches unfortunately being unappointed by ACTRRA members. However, on that note it was great to see the response from the clubs who were able to support by refereeing some of their own matches with club members. With a few more junior referees on board this season, we saw an increase in junior matches appointed which is a great positive however as always with the juniors there were still some unappointed matches which is not ideal.

It often goes by unnoticed, but personally I can't thank these men enough for the amount of work and coordination they do to make sure there was a referee at as many games as possible throughout the season.



We would really like to thank any referee who volunteered to fill in at the last minute to cover games with some people refereeing multiple games over the weekend.

Unfortunately, due to some issues with referee numbers and availability there was a decline in senior game allocations & total game allocations, however in a great sign for next year there was a 4.48% increase in junior game allocations, which has been on the decline for the last couple of years.

Brumbies Rugby Referee Department would like to thank Geoff, Steve & Rob for their great work again this year.

### Education and Training

Over the year, a number of educational programs and courses were run by Brumbies Rugby and the ARU. Next season, there will be a major focus on providing all of our referees with opportunities to progress and develop their accreditations and refereeing.

At the start of the season, we held a Blue Card refresher session at Brumbies HQ run by Brumbies Team Doctor Stephen Freeman. This was a great event that was open to all referees, club officials and trainers to update all members of the processes involved with the Blue Card which was introduced into all competitions in Australia this year after a successful trial held in Canberra and Newcastle last year.

There were a number of Foundation Course run this year, with another to be held November 18. A specific Referee Foundation Course was also held in May for those who had completed the Coaching component of the Foundation Course but not yet the Refereeing component. This course allowed a number of ACTRRA referees to complete their Referee Level 1 accreditation this season.

As mentioned previously, Brodie Ingram was again working with Brumbies Rugby for the Junior Referee Education. We would like to thank Brodie for his hard work again this year where we saw some very positive results this season.

Brodie ran RKR course across a number of different venues including Canberra Grammar, St Edmunds, Wests, Tuggeranong, Queanbeyan, Goulburn and Brumbies HQ. There was a total of 112 (70 last season) people who attended these courses over the 8 separate events.

We had a total of 17 young referees who completed all components of the Refereeing Kids Rugby accreditation and went on to referee for the entire junior season which is well up on last year's number of 9.

There will be another big push around junior referee recruitment in the build up to and throughout the 2019 season, with a large number of Refereeing Kid's Rugby courses running again. The main focus will be having a high transition rate from course attendee's into registered referees and getting on the field in 2019.

Brumbies Rugby would like to thank everyone that was involved in the educational programs, workshops and courses over the year.
